Oilseed rape de-risking

Given the risks around growing oilseed rape, we have an industry-leading contract that helps farmers to grow the crop without the typical financial risks associated with it should it fail.

The scheme removes the upfront seed costs as the payment date for any successfully established oilseed rape and companion crop seed is set up to 12 months following delivery. If the crops fail, the seed costs will be waived altogether.

With our agronomist and seed experts providing advice on rotational planning, establishment considerations, timing and input strategies, as well as the additional financial security provided by our de-risking contract, we are helping to improve the survival rate of this important crop.
